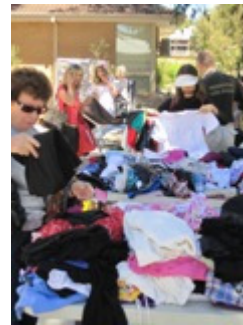
Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Day
