OTHER THINGS TO RECYCLE

The JFR (Jim) McGeough Resource Recovery Facility offers **free** recycling for residents. **None of these items should go in your kerbside bins:**

- Computers & printers
- TVs
- Batteries (all batteries including car and household)
- Fluorescent globes and tubes
- Hazardous waste (eg aerosols, household, garden, pool and vehicle chemicals, poisons, smoke detectors, fire extinguishers)
- Mobile phones
- Motor oil
- Paint
- Printer cartridges

You can also drop off the following for **free**:

- Scrap metal
- Cardboard



You can dispose of the following for a small fee:

- Asbestos (conditions apply),
